

# Working with a Loom

To help the children investigate other ways to put fabrics together, the teachers made a big loom for the children to weave fabric on. The children helped cut and tear fabric apart to create strips to put on the loom. The children then took turns weaving the fabric through the string. The children had to work on their patterning skills as they put the fabric under one string and over the next. The children worked on this loom for over a month. When the weaving was completed, the children took their work off the loom and hung it up so everyone could see their work of art.
